Deadline and Notifications

All applications must be received in their entirety by June 1st. Applications may be submitted quickly online by following the link provided at www.spiritofschuyler.org. The Spirit of Schuyler board utilizes a scoring rubric (and blind-review process to mask personal identifying information) to select award recipients. All applicants will be contacted with the outcome of their application.
